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### LETTER FROM THE CEO

2022 was a banner year for Embarc Collective. Now serving over 125 companies, we have achieved a level of density that enables connection, collaborations, and peer learning. We also expanded the breadth and depth of our offerings and raised the bar for ourselves for defining best-in-class startup support.

### WE WERE RANKED AS A TOP INCUBATION PROGRAM IN THE WORLD BY UBI GLOBAL.

UBI Global recognized Embarc Collective as a top incubation program in the world. Within just three years, Embarc Collective has achieved the level of impact to merit this global recognition and now gains the distinction of being only one of two US-based programs in the top rankings overall for 2021-2022.

### WE HOSTED THE 9TH ANNUAL STARTUP OF THE YEAR SUMMIT.

Embarc Collective was host to the national Startup of the Year Awards and Summit, powered by Established. We made sure that the 400 startups, venture investors, and corporate innovators attending from around the country experienced Tampa Bay's vibrant lifestyle and tech scene. Speakers at the event included Tampa Mayor Jane Castor; Jeff Vinik, Governor and Chairman of the Tampa Bay Lightning; Brian Murphy, Founder and CEO of ReliaQuest; Derrick Brooks, NFL Hall of Famer; and Jenn Limm, Co-Founder and CEO of Delivering Happiness.

### **WE EXPANDED OUR ROSTER OF WORLD-CLASS COACHES.**

Coaching is an integral part of Embarc Collective's support model. Our experienced coaching team provided over 1,700 hours of individualized coaching to startups, which was a 50% increase from 2021. In addition to increasing the total amount of coaching, we grew the breadth of our coaching areas with new Growth Marketing, UX Strategy, and Engineering expert areas.

# NAMED TOP CHALLENGER

UBI GLOBAL RECOGNIZED EMBARC COLLECTIVE AS A TOP INCUBATION PROGRAM IN THE WORLD IN ITS 2021 - 2022 RANKINGS OF BUSINESS INCUBATORS AND ACCELERATORS.

The UBI Global World Benchmark
Study 2021-2022 named Embarc
Collective as a Top Challenger in
North America. UBI defines Top
Challenger as a business incubator or
accelerator that stands out due to its
impressive overall impact and
performance achievements relative
to its respective regional peers.



Within just three years, Embarc Collective achieved the level of impact to merit this global recognition and gained the distinction of being only one of two US-based programs in the top rankings overall.

The performance and impact of Embarc Collective were measured across 21 KPIs against other programs from around the world. The Benchmark Study assessed 1,895 programs, received 356 applications, and ultimately benchmarked 109 programs. Just 41 organizations made the Top Performer or Challenger rankings.



Embarc Collective's model reflects the individual needs of each startup we support. Unlike a traditional incubator or accelerator, there is no assigned start and end date at Embarc Collective—startups remain supported by the Embarc Collective team until their needs outgrow our strengths.

This year, we celebrated the growth of two member companies, SiteZeus and Chattr, who transitioned to Alumni status. Both teams have scaled tremendously, so much so, that they've grown their team headquarters from within Embarc Collective to larger footprints in Tampa Bay. We are proud of both teams and to see our mission come to life—Florida's startup talent building bold, scalable, thriving companies.



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












## COACHING PROGRAM

































Coaching is at the core of Embarc Collective's distinct membership offering.

In 2022, members received 1,700 hours of individualized coaching and leveraged new support from our expanded roster of Growth Marketing, UX Strategy, and Engineering coaches.

With a deep bench of seasoned experts carrying impressive startup-building backgrounds, our coaching team brings a rich perspective to one-on-one strategy sessions with Embarc Collective members.

Founders and their teams can expect frameworks and feedback from coaches, who remain aligned to each startup's ever-evolving needs and milestones—ensuring timely, relevant, and high-quality support on a regular cadence.



## MEMBER PROGRAMMING



In addition to individualized coaching, members of Embarc Collective learn from experts through small-group workshops, summits, bootcamps, and wellness and community-building events. Our programming is custombuilt based on our members' needs and provides tactical content across sales, marketing, product, talent, and leadership development.

We pride ourselves in the quality of our programming. In 2022, members joined us for 70 programming sessions. The average rating of our programming was 3.8 out of 4.0. Our programming was led by a diverse lineup of experts, with 52% of speakers coming from outside the Tampa Bay market and nearly 67% of speakers from underrepresented backgrounds.

### LEVEL UP: 2022 STRATEGY + LEADERSHIP SUMMIT

In September, Embarc Collective hosted our 2022 Strategy & Leadership Summit with the support of The First Bank (fka Beach Bank). The Summit's theme was centered around leveling up one's leadership and called on top experts from a diverse set of experiences in tech, sports, hospitality, and real estate.

### **PROGRAMMING**



### FINANCIAL BOOTCAMP

A financial model is a numerical representation of a startup's business plan, used to set strategy, convey vision, and measure success. This bootcamp provided members with the tools to create a financial model for their startup that can be adapted as their business evolves.

### ANNUAL PLANNING WORKSHOP

To explore the topic of annual planning for early-stage companies, Embarc Collective collaborated with Accenture, a Fortune Global 500 consulting company, to lead a Strategic Planning Workshop for our community of member startups. This is a critical practice for startups—to zoom out of day-to-day execution and make a deliberate effort to work on the business, instead of in the business.



### **BUILD WITHOUT BURNOUT**

It can be difficult to create space to process, problem-solve, and move forward when you're a startup founder. You have to concurrently navigate multiple professional and personal dynamics with limited bandwidth. Research shows that founders are 50% more likely to report having mental health struggles, 10x more likely to suffer from bipolar disorder, and 2x more likely to suffer depression.

Our 6-month Build Without Burnout Series, built by the experts at Pilea, who coach venture-backed founders on how to reach their fullest potential, was launched to combat this issue head-on.



### **INVESTOR FLY-IN**

In September, Embarc Collective hosted its inaugural Investor Fly-In to bring national investors to Tampa Bay to experience the growing startup community. We coordinated over 100 1:1 meetings between Embarc Collective member companies and investors from Calm Company Fund, Grotech Ventures, Overlooked Ventures, Panoramic Ventures, Rise of the Rest Seed Fund, Updata Partners, and more.

### **GROWTH MARKETING SUMMIT**

With the support of TriNet and Brex, we hosted our Growth Marketing Summit in May. As so many of the members of Embarc Collective grow and build out their marketing leadership, we wanted to create space for those individuals to learn about different approaches to take with their growth marketing strategies. We flew in amazing experts from national high-growth startups, including PandaDoc, Drift, and Brex, to share their playbooks for how they have achieved exponential growth.









# COMMUNITY EVENTS

As the central landing zone for the Tampa Bay tech community, Embarc Collective fosters community events and conversations around the topics of technology, entrepreneurship, and innovation.

This year we unveiled the ReliaQuest Auditorium @ Embarc Collective. With this new space, we aim to showcase the growth and engagement of ReliaQuest, the force multiplier of security operations and one of the few local companies to surpass the coveted \$1B unicorn valuation, with the local startup community.

Embarc Collective hosted over 160 community events in 2022—from company meetings to workshops and meetup groups including EO Tampa Bay, Tampa Devs, Blacks in Tech, The Mainframe, Tampa Bay Bitcoin Meetup, and High Tech Connect.



### **BLACK FOUNDERS DEMO DAY**

In July, Embarc Collective hosted the Tampa Bay Region's Black Founders Demo Day, a regional event leading up to Black Founders Demo Day in Miami. The winning company was also guaranteed a spot to present at Venture Atlanta, and eMerge Americas, and received a 6-month scholarship to Embarc Collective, among other prizes.

Embarc Collective member Brian Alvarez-Bailey, Founder and CEO of fintech startup Allison, won first place and advanced to the finals in Miami.

### THE OC EMPORIUM



# GLARING GAP SUMMIT 2022

In November, Embarc Collective hosted the third annual Glaring Gap Summit, sponsored by ReliaQuest, to provide startup investment training to over 50 women across Florida—from college students to mid-level professionals, accredited investors, and everyone in between.

The Glaring Gap Summit isn't your typical speaker conference. Instead, the Summit provided an interactive investor education to its attendees, blending inspirational startup leader speakers with tactical deep dives on due diligence, startup valuations, and venture math considerations for building a startup investment portfolio.

The feedback we received on this year's Glaring Gap Summit reinforced that providing intentional, intensive education on startup investing can create a meaningful impact.

# TECH TRANSPLANT NETWORK

Moving from a major tech market to Florida can be quite the transition — we know firsthand. We've done it. And we also get asked about it often.

Given the curiosity and demand, we created an informal network of individuals new to our market in 2019—the Tech Transplant Network. Over the past three years, the network has grown to over 140 transplants from hubs including San Francisco, New York City, Chicago, and Boston.

Working in partnership with the regional Hi Tampa Bay initiative, we gather for breakfast on a quarterly basis with the shared goal of welcoming tech and tech-adjacent newcomers to the Tampa Bay region.
